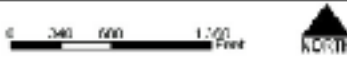

 THIS KEY MAP ILLUSTRATES THE LOCATION OF PUBLIC VIEWPOINTS USED TO PHOTOGRAPH THE EXISTING CANYON HILLS PROJECT SITE. VIEWPOINTS WERE FIELD-MAPPED AND THEN LOCATED IN THE FIELD USING A TRIPOD WITH A GPS LOCALITY AND 1/4 INCH TANGENT FIELD USING GIS TO THE 3-DIMENSIONAL TOPOGRAPHIC BASE MAP USED TO PREPARE THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT SITE PLAN. THE VIEW CONES SHOWN FOR EACH VANTAGE POINT IS APPROXIMATE AND ILLUSTRATES THE PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGE AREA SHOWN IN THE "BEFORE AND AFTER" VISUAL SIMULATIONS. THE PHOTOGRAPHY WAS DONE WITH A HIGH-RESOLUTION DIGITAL CAMERA UTILIZING EFFECTIVELY 30MM LENS FOR INDIVIDUAL PHOTOGRAPHS. TO OBTAIN THE PANORAMAS REQUIRED FOR THE "BEFORE AND AFTER" VISUAL SIMULATIONS, THE PHOTOGRAPHS WERE STITCHED TOGETHER IN PHOTOSHOP TO ELIMINATE SEAMS. THE RESULTING PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPOSITE WAS USED AS THE "BEFORE" IMAGE. TO MODEL THE PROPOSED 3-DIMENSIONAL MODEL OF THE DEVELOPMENT WAS ADDED TO CREATE THE "AFTER" IMAGE.
