

I have lived in Tuiunga for 11 yeera very dose to the proposed Canyon Hills project After reviewing the DEIR I have found many inacturacles and ornissions．

According to the cument laws the ，ates is not zoned for 280 homes．＇The current laws do not allowigrading ridgelines by as much as 80 feet and peimanently altering 310 acrist．

Living in this area for 11 years I am n cifizan wheit and I know that this development with effect many more criyotes than thie up to 5 thet the plan states． The developments negative impact on roadrunnera，birds，raccoonis，owls and rabhits，plants and trees is understated．It doos．not take into consideration the enormity of this projects＇development arep or the fact that these animals food source will be ramoved when the mature isiens are destroyed and replaced by small trees and seedilings in the right of way where the witdife will not be able to oet to them．Also there was a Cougar stiod on this propeity，whicf the DEIR does not mention．

Public safety is another concerm．We cumerituly do not have proper police protection．It takes over 14 minutes for police to raspond in this area（if they respond at all），when it is onty supposed to take 7 minutes．My neighbor has asked pollce to drive by her home because there are people loitering in cars outside her door．They dispose of．their cigaretties in a normsmoking area（due to fire hazard）and llquor botties on her property．We have not seen a palice car yet This area does not heve proper piolice coyerage and with the inumber of homes proposed in the DEIR，which is not legai－to．build will make police coverage worse．

The DEIR does not take accurately take into considieration the acoumuletive aftect of all the developmeni projects that have just＇teceintly been complated or that are in the works．For excample，the developinerit at Wentworith＇and the development planned on the hilisides above Day St．In Tujunga．The traffic on Foothill has increased tremendously over the last 11 years．Our streets cannot handle the additional traficic ther this 280 ．development will bring．The DEIR does not address how this developronen will affect Foothill Bouleverd，where all locals do their shopping．

Another concern is publlo works．Public works is lacking already in this areas．I arn a citizen expert on thie issue． 1 have asked the cify for years to repeir our tom up road and all 1 get is a work order number and told that it is on the list work from this project

The DEIR does not adequately eddress the affect thet this project will have on sir pollution during the construction end after the coristruction with the additional 280 homes and at least 2，700 extra trip＇s per day on Le Tuna Canyon and surrournding streets．This area used to be where kids with asthmacould come to breathe better．South Coast Air Quality Manngement should do a shudy on how this project will affect the air poltution in the aroa．This area is a commuting workforce because there is no irndustry close by 80 all of these new＇homes will require a significant corsmute time that will make the air quality wotee．
I urge Los Angeles Clty officfats to disepprove any portion of the Canyon Hills project that requires changes to the ourrent Los．Angigeles City Generral Plan，Los Angeles Municipal Code，local Community Plians，thit Hillside Ordinance，the Slope Density Ordinarice，the Oak Tree Ordinarica ard all current zoning and all
current laws．
